After School Club

Our After School Club runs every day from 3.15 - 5.30 p.m. Children enjoy craft, cooking, indoor games, etc. There are spaces available if you would like your child/ren to attend. The After School Club children can be collected from the Football and Drama Clubs if necessary. Charges are £3.00 per child for each session from 3.15 – 4.15 p.m. and 4.15 – 5.30 p.m. and £5 for the 3.15 – 5.30 p.m. session. Please send your money in at the beginning of the term for all sessions if you know your child/ren will be using the Club on a regular basis. For more irregular users, payment should be sent in when booking your child/ren into the Club. Please remember that we have **to operate a system of charging £1 per child for every 5 minutes that you are late collecting your child/ren.** Registration forms for new users are available from the School Office. Thank you to Mrs C Bowcott, Miss E Porter, Mrs S White for working in the Club, and to Mrs E Heal for being our 'occasional' helper.
